Old Business

MPA Archives: Tom Broido reported on the University of Maryland Agreement, who will finalize arrangements for the signing of the agreement. It was understood that substantive changes to the agreement would require Jim Kendrick's review prior to signing.

<u>Press & Publicity</u>: Jenny Bilfield reported on the results of a poll sent to MPA members. As there were only 10-12 responses, more publisher input is necessary prior to deciding the direction of the MPA's publicity campaign. Bilfield suggested that, with Janna Mattson's help, the Press/Publicity/Public Relations Committee poll those publishers

who did not respond. Fred Anton suggested that the Board proceed with publicity plans for the Paul Revere Awards as a subset of whatever focus the MPA publicity campaign might take.

A Motion authorizing Jenny Bilfield and Lynn Sengstack to solicit a proposal from Cohen, Davids & Bigar for the marketing of the Paul Revere Awards was approved.

New Business

 $\underline{\text{New Membership Applications}}$: A motion to approve the application of $\underline{\text{Ensemble Publications}}$ for membership in the MPA was approved.

<u>Counsel</u>: Jim Kendrick felt that the "user friendly" version of the copyright guidelines meets the legal standards with a few minor exceptions. A motion to accept the copyright guidelines as modified by Jim Kendrick and John Shorney was approved.
